Availability

Provo Power plans to give out 300 trees which will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Only one (1) tree will be given per address every third year. Customers are to refer to the program website at www.switchitprovo.com for the latest information on the program. Applications must include all the required information. It is the responsibility of the customer to submit a fully completed application. Incomplete applications will be returned with a reason for the denial and how to re-apply. Funds will not be held in reserve for incomplete applications.

Purpose

Trees strategically placed around your home, paved areas and air conditioners can have a significant impact on your cooling costs. As a municipal-owned utility, Provo Power is interested in lowering costs to Provo consumers. Lower power bills save you money, conserve energy, and help the utility reduce the need to purchase power, especially at expensive peak times.

Eligibility

The Trees for Energy Conservation Program is available only to existing residential Provo City customers in good standing. Only customers with central air conditioning, not a swamp cooler, qualify. Only one tree will be given per customer every three (3) years.

Approval and Verification

Provo Power and its respective agents reserve the right to verify eligibility.

Online Application Form

The online application form must be filled out completely, truthfully, and accurately. The Customer must sign and submit the application. The Customer agrees that all the information is true and accurate and has conformed to the terms and conditions for the Trees for Energy Conservation Program. All information to pick up the tree will be provided to the customer upon approval.

Funding

Funding for this program is provided by the Provo City Energy Department within the Energy Services Programs.

Warranties

Provo City makes no warranties or representations of any kind, whether statutory, expressed, or implied, including without limitations, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose regarding the trees provided by the contracted nursery, grower, or contractor. The Customer should contact the nursery about any warranties. All trees shed leaves, twigs, flowers or a fruiting structure at some time. There is no tree that is completely maintenance free.
